STAY SAFE WITH LP GAS THIS WINTER

Get your LP Gas now, and use it safely!

A gas heater is an efficient, effective way to heat your home and if you follow a few simple safety rules, it's incredibly safe as well.

Before you switch your gas heater on this winter, do a quick quality and safety check for storage

damage, such as perished hoses or washers, which can lead to gas leaks.

Once you've done your quality check and your heater is safe to use, tick off our gas safety checklist below to enjoy a cosy evening at home, safely.

Use LP Gas Safely...

- Read the instructions carefully before connecting and switching on your heater.
- Always make sure there is sufficient "fresh air" or "ventilation" in the room where an LP Gas flame is burning.
- Never leave a heater on when no one is in a room.
- The gas cylinder must fit into the back of the heater cabinet. It must not stand outside the unit.
- Check that the "O" ring (washer) is not brittle, cracked or perished.
- Only buy your LP Gas from reputable dealers.
- Make sure there is a branded seal on the cylinder valve.
- A "clear" unmarked seal or "no" seal indicates the cylinder has been filled illegally.
- Do not store excess LP Gas cylinders on your property.
- "Empty" cylinders contain gas vapour, and can be dangerous. Please return empty cylinders to the appropriate dealers.
